At Hustle PHX, we want to let the hustlers hustle - for the common good. Some of the best natural entrepreneurs in the United States are in underserved urban communities. They are called hustlers - visionary risk-takers who seize the opportunity to move product and turn a profit. They have the God-given skills, attributes, and talents of an entrepreneur, but they lack key resources needed to create sustainable businesses that benefit the broader community. Through our program, we provide a limited number of carefully selected entrepreneurs with three essential kinds of capital: intellectual capital, social capital, and financial capital.

Letter from the Hustle PHX CEO



Thank you for supporting Hustle PHX in the development of entrepreneurs throughout urban communities in our city. This past year (2020), was extremely challenging. On January 1st, 2021, I took some time to reflect on the mission statement of Hustle PHX. Our mission statement says, "Motivated by Christian faith, we encourage the creation of sustainable business ventures that affirm the dignity of people and lead to the flourishing of all communities in Phoenix."

Ultimately, in my reflection, I was struck by how the Lord has opened doors and brought strategic partners, donors, and volunteers to support and serve entrepreneurs in under-served communities throughout Phoenix.

This past year we have done so many things to support the entrepreneurs. We have supported the entrepreneurs in getting \$500 cash assistance to over 50 entrepreneurs in our network. We were also able to lend 10 entrepreneurs loans totaling \$12,500; each entreprenuer successfully paid their loan back despite the pandemic!


Lastly, we were able to povide immediate business support to entrepreneurs by connecting them to grants provided by the City of Phoenix and other foundations. This support helped entrepreneurs navigate the PPP loan process, and secure PPP funding to keep their businesses open.


It is our faith in Jesus Christ that drives us "to be a blessing" by using our gifts/ talents to love people through serving!

By providing social capital, Hustle and its volunteers provide a deep and wide network to entrepreneurs, outside of where they were placed in life. The In-





Hustle PHX has relaunched the Hustle PHX 202 Program to better support entrepreneurs as they grow and scale their businesses

Please read a recent article by The Phoenix Business Journal in regards to the program:

"To position our business development programs to better scale with the organization, we needed to perform some serious development on our Hustle PHX 202 program.

The former Hustle PHX 202 model required intensive staff time to execute the program and it required volunteers to recreate workshop materials for 12-14 workshops each cohort! This model was not scalable.

To solve this problem, Acton University gave us their online MBA curriculum and we hired a recent graduate of the W. P. Carey School of Business to help us create our own curriculum for the Hustle PHX 202 program.

This curriculum will give us pre-made materials that volunteers can use to facilitate our workshops (instead of needing volunteers to remake the materials over-and-over again). Additionally, we've restructured the program so that our Hustle PHX staff members are not needed to run the workshop on a weekly basis; they will now be run by volunteers.

This frees up our staff time to invest into other important areas of the organization, like partnership development and discipleship of our entrepreneurs and volunteers."

List Services / Programs



Hustle PHX 101 provides entrepreneurial and business development training to entrepreneurs aspiring to launch or grow their business. Participants explore their purpose in starting their business, understand who God created them to be, and how to develop a successful business that brings restoration to individuals

HUSTLE PHX 202

and communities.

Hustle PHX 202 continues the business development process for entrepreneurs who have graduated from the 101 program by providing access to business mentors who walk alongside the participant during the course of the program. Additionally, participants attend weekly workshops designed to help validate the participant's business concept.

HUSTLE PHX 303

Hustle PHX 303 is a one-year advisory program for select entrepreneurs who have completed 101 and 202. Each participant is provided with a team of expert a dvisors in the fields of sales, marketing, finance, operations, legal, and risk management and is also given access to \$20,000 in low-interest loans. Participants will walk away from the program with the proper understanding, tools, and routines to scale their businesses for the purpose of providing value to their customers and bringing restoration to the lives of those impacted by the participants' businesses.

HUSTLE PHX AFFINITY LOAN PROGRAM

Provides microloans in a group setting which serves as a networking and credit building space for small business owners who have close ties to each other. The program also provides business consulting and montly workshops. The payments are reported to the credit bureaus over a 12-month period.

OYE WADDELL - FOUNDER AND CEO

is the Founder and CEO of Hustle Phoenix. Fueled by his visionary style of leader-ship and the belief that all people have dignity, Oye knows that some of the most innovative entrepreneurs in the United States are in underserved, urban communities.

Prior to moving to Phoenix, Oye served as Executive Director of Eternal Sports Outreach in Los Angeles, which sought to empower young athletes to become business and civic leaders. There he recruited volunteer coaches/administrators, evaluated the effectiveness of development programs and utilized evaluation data to revise instructional objectives and methods.

Once in Phoenix, Oye founded and served as CEO of Gameplan AZ-an athletic consulting company dedicated to providing student-athletes and their families the tools to navigate and dominate the athletic recruiting process. While Ove's long track record in urban education and entrepreneurship began as a teacher in both Compton and Los Angeles, he continues to invest in students by serving on the American Enterprise Institute with the Ideas Council where he invests in student leaders at universities across the nation. His influence is also present at Arizona State University where Oye is a Venture Mentor for student-athletes who aim to start businesses.

Oye served as a pastor at New City Church, leading members and the broader community to understand, embrace, and accomplish their mission to develop disciples locally and globally, as well as engage followers in worship, community and ministry.

More recently, Oye Waddell served as pastor of Sojourn Village PHX-a community dedicated to seeking the flourishing of an urban community known as South Phoenix. With this same passion for families, Oye is also the CEO of the Hustle Real Estate Investment Fund which is designed to serve as a pathway to homeownership for low-income individuals, helping to stabilize low-income neighborhoods and bring stability to families.

Oye was selected by the Phoenix Business Journal as among the city's Top 40 Under 40 Business Men and Women for 2018. He is also a member of the Camelback Society, an association of men called to the marketplace who intend to live all aspects of their lives before Christ.

Conscious Capitalism is a movement that focuses on businesses that have a purpose beyond profit. Oye Waddell has also been a Ted Style Talk Speaker on topics such as "Hustling for the Common Good" at Purdue University as well as a business conference speaker for Balle, an organization that fights for the flourishing of local businesses.

Oye attended the University of Washington on a full athletic football scholarship. He later earned a Master of Public Administration from the University of Southern California and a Master of Education from Arizona State University.

Oye, his wife Crys, and their four young children, Chariot, Clover, Crescent, and Oye II currently reside in Phoenix, Arizona.
